

INFORMATION

All play is governed by USGA Rules. Yellow lines or stakes indicate water hazards. Red lines or stakes indicate lateral water hazards. White stakes indicate out of bounds. The golf course uses reclaimed water.

LOCAL RULES

- Out of Bounds: Is defined by perimeter fences, stenciled street curbs, and white lines. Out of bounds on the right side of hole #3 is defined by the inside edge of the street curb.
- Lateral Water Hazards: Are defined by red lines on holes 4 (behind the green), 5, 6, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 18.
- Staked Trees: If the tree or stake interferes with stance or swing, drop one club length from the nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole, without penalty.
- Embedded Ball: Through the green, a ball that is embedded in its own pitch-mark in the ground, other than sand, may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it lay no nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green. (Appendix 1, part B: 3)
- Ground Under Repair: Marked with white lines and relief is governed by rule 25-1.
- Bunkers: There are large pebbles/rocks in some of the bunkers. If either of these interfere with your swing or could be hazardous to your health please remove them from the bunker without penalty. Also, if the liners in the bottom of the bunkers come loose and are visible please move your ball to a different part of the bunker to avoid injury and immediately report it to the golf shop.
- Special Note #1: The bathrooms and natural areas beyond the cart path behind #4 green are to be played as a lateral hazard. A one(1) stroke penalty will be incurred, and the player will take a drop at the nearest point of relief no closer to the hole.
- Hole #17 Pathway: If your ball ends up on the dirt path from the cart path to #17 green, then the player gets a free drop at the nearest point of relief, no nearer to the hole.
- Waste Bunkers: The cross bunker and the bunker on the left side of #9, all the way up to the green, are now waste bunkers. The last bunker on the right side of #15 and the first bunker on the right of #16 are also waste bunkers. These bunkers are marked with fountain grasses inside of them. Waste bunkers are not considered any type of hazard so you are able to ground your club.

COURTESY OF PLAY

- All signs/ropes must be observed.
- Keep pace with group ahead.
- Sand/replace divots, repair ball marks and rake bunkers.
- Proper golf attire is required.
- Golf carts shall be driven on fairways and/or designated cart paths.
- Golf carts shall not be operated within 30 yards of any putting green.
- Yardage disks in middle of fairway are measured to front, middle, and back of green.
- Under no circumstance is any part of the golf course to be used for practice (no dropping and hitting shots repeatedly).
